extracranial cerebrovascular disease :

- *carotid stenosis treated with many carotid endarterectomy (more than 1.500 interventions) and with stenting*

- *stenosis, aneurysms treated with open and endovascular surgery*
- *surgery of the varicose veins*
- *extremity amputations*
